Over the last month, 7 crimes have been recorded in Rogiet.

There has been a decrease in the number of crimes reported in the Rogiet area from 10 to 7 since last month's report. Some of these crimes are still under investigation.

The above chart shows that for the last 28 days, there have been 5 different recorded crimes. The highest offences are Public Order and Violence Without Injury offences.

There have been no concerning trends or patterns of note identified from April's statistics.

Good Work

- Regular patrols have been taking place in the community on foot and on the police bike, targeting Anti-Social Behaviour (ASB) Hotspots.
- PCSO Tobie van Arkel and Karig Jackson attended Rogiet Council meeting. Concerns were raised in relation to Anti-Social Behaviour and drug dealing. As a result, increased patrols have been conducted in ASB and drug-dealing hotspots. Furthermore, intelligence has been submitted, and appropriate enquiries have been made.
- Concerns have been raised about the subject of parking on pavements and causing unnecessary obstructions in the area of Meadway in Rogiet.
